CPCCWHS1001 Work safely in the construction industry

This unit of competency specifies the mandatory work health and safety training required prior to undertaking construction work.

This course will provide you with the skills & knowledge to demonstrate personal awareness and knowledge of health and safety legislative requirements in order to work safely and prevent injury or harm to self and others.

Who can do this course?

All persons, minimum 14 years of age, who may be required to enter any construction site in a range of situations, including owner builders, volunteers and workplace settings.

Pre-requisites

Satisfactory language, literacy, numeracy and oral communication skills to identify and control construction hazards and risk. A general state of health and fitness to select and fit common personal protective equipment (PPE) used for construction work.

What to bring

A pen, 100 points of ID, Your USI*

Licensing, legislative, regulatory or certification requirements apply to this unit. Relevant work health and safety state and territory regulatory authorities should be consulted to confirm jurisdictional requirements.
